Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Tax Act
of 1993

The Arizona Equal Justice Foundation is a non-profit corporation and listed under Section 501 (a) of the Internal Revenue Code as having 501 (c) status.

The Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Tax Act of 1993 requires that charities give written substantiation (other than a cancelled check) of any gift of \$250 or more (cash or property) to a donor. Congress stipulated that the acknowledgment must 'provide information sufficient to substantiate the amount of the deductible contribution.' The receipt must also describe the property, however, it is the donor who establishes the fair market value of said property. If no goods or services were provided, the receipt must indicate this.
