Credit Card Contributions  
and  
Tax Information

Contributions to the Arizona Equal Justice Foundation are 100% tax deductible. Each donor (individual donor or lawfirm contribution) will receive a tax statement for their financial records at the time of receipt of the donation. Should a copy of a tax statement be required at any time, please contact the AEJF office at 602-258-3434x2150.

Donations are credited for the present tax year using the date on the check, i.e. if a check is dated December 31, 2009 but received in our offices and posted as received on January 5, 2010, the donation is considered a tax deductible donation for 2009. We record checks dated through December 31, 2009 as 2009 donations, as long as they are received in our office on or before January 15, 2010.

Credit card donations must be posted and dated the day they are called into the appropriate credit card company (AMEX, DISCOVER, MasterCard, VISA). We make every effort to charge against credit cards the day we receive authorization from the donor, whether that notice is made by mail, or via phone. Credit card donations received through January 15, 2010 will be considered a 2009 donation if the donor requests. The accompanying tax statement will state that the gift was a 2009 donation.
